Patrick S. Ford is currently living and working in West Yorkshire, UK, while studying for a PhD in Performing Arts with the University of Plymouth. His art education began at Leeds Arts University (UK) - receiving a 'Merit', at Northumbria University (UK) – receiving a BA (Hons) Fine Art degree, and at RMIT University (Aus.) – receiving an MFA degree. He previously held the post of Associate Lecturer in the Department of Communication and Design at RMIT University Vietnam (Saigon South Campus), where he lived for 3 years.

He has exhibited his work in solo and group shows in Europe and Asia beginning in 1982 and since then has participated in over 100 exhibitions and art projects. His work is held in several public collections in Europe and Asia and in numerous private collections.

Before moving to Vietnam, Patrick had lived in Hong Kong for 25 years and for 10 of those years years he worked as a founding partner in a modelmaking company, undertaking work for architects, landscape architects, engineers, urban planners, developers, photographers and designers.

Patrick also worked as a teacher at every educational level from kindergarten through to Higher Education.

For the last 7 years of his time in Hong Kong Patrick worked at the Hong Kong Design Institute where, as a lecturer, he taught numerous subjects to Higher Diploma and BA Degree level students.

He participated in the curriculum writing and validation teams for the new *Higher Diploma in Visual Arts and Culture* programme as well as teaching many of the programme's constituent modules and also participated in the validation and accreditation team for the new *BA (Hons) Fine Art* Programme, run in collaboration with Birmingham City University in the UK.

Patrick was Course Leader of the Fine Art Degree programme, working closely with the Course Leader of the home programme and making visits to Birmingham to attend programme monitoring boards.

Originally trained as a sculptor, Patrick has also worked as a printmaker and is currently pursuing projects involving the development of an approach to drawing methodology and performance, especially that related to *Walking Art*. His practice often seeks to take artmaking out into the environment to encourage observation, reflection and response, and just as often focuses on the border between disciplines.

Some of Patrick's most recent projects have involved collaboration with other artists, usually internationally, which has encouraged the exploration of alternative working methods using Skype, social media, the employment of specific apps etc.

These lines of investigation are feeding directly back into his practice, forming a kind of virtuous circle of working methods.

# No holiday

In this performance, entitled '*No holiday*', Ford continues his practice of deconstructing everyday life for paradigms that can be isolated and examined within a durational event that attempts to retrace an action or an activity observed in life, exploring and reconfiguring observed movements he calls 'found actions'.

For many working people the highlight of the year is the annual summer holiday. During this short, intense period people remove themselves from their habitual surroundings and immerse themselves enthusiastically into what is often unfamiliar geographical and/or cultural territory.

'No holiday' deals with the journey to and from this holiday adventure, reversing the usual paradigm by focusing on the journey rather than the destination and eliminating the relief felt upon arrival at the intended holiday location. Ford will take his suitcase, map and selfie stick everywhere with him as he explores the choreography of the holiday experience in unfamiliar surroundings.

'No holiday' has been live streamed twice from Hong Kong, first to an audience on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2017, from 07:00am to 09:00am (Hong Kong time) as part of the '*Duration & Dialogue II Performance Art Festival 2017*' in Toronto, Canada, and again on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017, from 05:00am to 07:00am (Hong Kong time) as part of the '*Inverse Performance Art Festival 2017*' in Northwest Arkansas, USA.

On 30<sup>th</sup> March 2019 from 10:00am to 10:30am UTC (5:00pm – 5:30pm Vietnam Time) 'No holiday' was live-streamed from Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam as part of the '**11<sup>th</sup> Online Performance Art Festival'**, internet-wide.

The latest live enactment of the performance was conducted on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2019 on Nguyen Hue in District 1 of HCMC, Vietnam broadcasting via Skype to the '4<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Psychogeography' held at Huddersfield University in the UK.

# Performative Walking

As a member of the *Walking Artist Network*, I engage in solo or collaborative performative walks. The walks can be psychogeographic in nature or they may form active research, gathering data in support of a project that becomes realised in other media.

# Landscape Drawing



My current landscape drawing project is the end result of collaboration between the natural landscape and myself. My aim is to combine the natural marks and textures created by the technique of rubbing or 'frottage' and the sympathetic application of marks and tones added later in the studio. This frottage is a tactile interaction with the actual rocks I draw. It is as though I am 'modelling' the rocks in clay or similar material, attempting to trace their physical outline, an action that could somehow leave residue of their presence on the paper. As I use my hands to sense the form of the rocks I gain an understanding of their make-up, which allows me to respond in an empathetic way. I then continue to work on the image in order to clarify the imprint the rocks had left. In the studio I tried to find equilibrium between the marks that were directed by textures and fractures in the rocks and my later response to them in the studio. The rocks lead the way by setting out a basic structure, the scope of the drawing, and I then later follow their lead by responding to their clues and hints.
